Directions to Landfill Sites

Ingoldsby

Located at 1674 Ingoldsby Road. Take County Road 21 to Kashagawigamog Lake Road. Travel through Ingoldsby to the first road on the right past the bridge. Landfill is approximately ½ km on the left. Or take County Road 1 (Gelert Road) to Ingoldsby Road and follow for approximately 3km.

Irondale

Located 2309 Milburn Road 1km west of County Road 503, or 8km east of County Road 1(Gelert Road).

Iron Mine

Located at 1100 Ironmine Road Davis Lake Road. Davis Lake Road is located north of Miner's Bay Lodge off Highway No. 35. Go east on Davis Lake Road 4km. At the "y" in the road by the Radio Tower, take straight branch (left), 1km to landfill site.

Little Gull

Located 1611 Deep Bay Road. Take Highway 35 North to Bobcaygeon Road. Travel through Minden to and turn Left onto Deep Bay Road (County Road 2) Follow road approximately 4 km. Or take Highway 35 South of Minden approximately 14 km south, just south of Little Gull Lake to Turn onto Deep Bay Road, follow the road for approximately 4 km.

Scotch Line

Located at 2308 Scotch Line Road. Take Highway 35 North to Scotch Line Road (just past the Subaru dealership on the left hand side). Turn left onto Scotch Line Road. Follow road approximately 1 km. Landfill is on the left. Or take Bobcaygeon Road North to Scotch Line Road, turn right onto Scotch Line.

Household Hazardous Waste

(Please visit www.mindenhills.ca for designated days each year.)

Household Hazardous Waste is accepted at the Scotch Line Landfill Site **ONLY** on Designated Hazardous Waste Days.

Acceptable Hazardous Waste

Rechargeable batteries (i.e. Telephone & cell phone batteries), small household batteries, fluorescent bulbs, CFL bulbs, printer ink jets, toner cartridges, empty aerosol cans – place in the RED bins at Scotch Line landfill site, all other sites, please give to the landfill attendant. DRY & EMPTY paint cans may be placed in the metal bins.

Oil Containers

Oil and Anti-Freeze containers as well as hydraulic pails and jugs **must be empty**.

Accepted on Hazardous Waste Event Days Only

Latex and oil paints, finishing products; i.e., varnish, glues, etc., used motor oil, auto and marine batteries, propane tanks and cylinders, cleaners such as bleach, oven cleaner, etc., aerosol cans, solvents; i.e., varsol, paint thinners, pesticides and herbicides, pool and photographic

Unacceptable Waste Classes

Needles/Sharps, PCB's radioactive and pathological waste

Recycling
(No charge at all sites)

FIBERS <i>Please do not package "fibers" in plastic bags.</i>	
Newspapers, Magazines and Books	Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, glossy flyers, ad inserts, phone books and soft cover books
Boxboard & Mixed Paper	Household & office paper, mail and envelopes, writing, computer & wrapping paper, greeting cards, cereal, detergent, tissue and shoe boxes, paper towel & toilet paper tubes, fiber egg cartons and plastic lined cat & dog food bags, paper shopping bags
Corrugated Cardboard	Pizza boxes & cardboard boxes. Clean & flatten. No waxed corrugated boxes or soiled pizza boxes.
CONTAINERS <i>Please rinse out bottles, jars and other containers.</i>	
Glass Bottles and Jars	All clear and coloured glass food and beverage containers
Tetra Pak Boxes, Plastic Containers & Lids	Pop & water bottles, yogurt, margarine, ice cream, clear fruit/veggie containers, ketchup, dish soap, bleach, shampoo and vitamin bottles (marked 1-7 on the bottom), peanut butter jars, plastic milk bags, fabric softener, laundry detergent, juice, milk, soup & other "Tetra Pak" type boxes. No Straws.
"Gable-Top" Cartons	Polycoat (waxed) milk, juice, sugar & liquid egg cartons coffee cups and fast food containers, paper plates (clean of food).
Metal Cans & Foil	All tin & aluminum food & beverage cans. Clean aluminum foil, pie plates & take-out trays. Rinse & remove lids on tin cans, place inside can and pinch closed.
Other Plastic Containers & Lids	Windshield washer fluid, oil and anti-freeze containers
Polystyrene (Styrofoam)	Meat and bakery trays, egg cartons, No blue or pink Styrofoam
Construction Material	Sort the metal, concrete, wood and shingles.
NON ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	
NO cosmetic containers, toothpaste tubes, stretch wrap, insulation, packing Styrofoam peanuts or beads. Vinyl siding, shower curtains, blister packs, coat hangers, foil laminates i.e. foil gift wrap, potato chip bags, tissues or paper towels. Milk, bread, shopping and dry cleaning bags. Wrap from toilet paper, paper towels, etc., bubble or boat wrap, tarps or other large sheets of plastic film.	

Recycling must be in blue boxes or transparent bags which must be dumped

Household Waste Unsorted (pick-up or trailer, bins, compactor trucks, dump trucks)	\$50.00 per cubic yard
Household Waste Sorted for Compactor Trucks and Bins	\$35.00 per cubic yard
Tires – Car and Truck Accepted at Scotch Line only	No charge - 5 tires allowed per trip Tires on rims are accepted
All Metal and Appliances – Except CFC (this is anything made of metal and includes but is not limited to, stoves, washers, dryers, etc.)	No Charge
CFC Appliances (Refrigerators, freezers, air conditions etc.) Accepted at Scotch Line Only	No Charge for tagged appliances \$50.00 per appliance
Furniture – per unit Mattress, Box Spring – per unit Carpet 10' x 10' – per unit	\$10.00 per unit Scotchline and Irondale Landfill Sites only
Commercial and Household Refuse Sorted (pick-up or trailer, bins, compactor trucks, dump trucks)	\$25.00 per cubic yard
Commercial Refuse Unsorted (pick-up or trailer, bins, compactor trucks, dump trucks)	\$50.00 per cubic yard
Construction Material Sorted (pick-up or trailer, bins, compactor trucks, dump trucks)	\$40.00 per cubic yard
Construction Material Unsorted (pick-up or trailer, bins, compactor trucks, dump trucks)	\$80.00 per cubic yard
Approved Contaminated Soil	\$20.00 per cubic yard
Oil Tanks – per tank (must not contain any oil)	Must have a 2' x 2' hole <u>or</u> cut in half – No Charge
Propane Tanks	Accepted at Scotchline only – No Charge
Boats	\$2.00 per foot if stripped of all metal \$4.00 per foot if not stripped of all metal
E-Waste, television, monitors, etc.	Free – Scotchline Landfill and Irondale Landfill Sites
Boat Shrink Wrap is permitted at Scotchline Landfill Site only within the month of July	\$5.00 per wrap
Brush	No Charge - Accepted at Ingoldsby, Iron Mine and Irondale
Yard Waste – grass clippings, leaves, weeds	No Charge – Accepted at Scotchline, Ingoldsby, Iron Mine and Irondale
