## **Horseshoe Lake Road – Extension of Lane Closure** Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

**Peterborough, Ontario, August 1, 2017** – Horseshoe Lake Road (County Road 20) near the Horseshoe Lake Dam, South of Bethel Road, will remain open to one lane of traffic only, until mid-September. The road has been closed to facilitate work to replace Horseshoe Lake Dam, part of the Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site.

Parks Canada is thankful for the community's patience with the road closure and the work thus far. As the work continues, the public is asked to refrain from using the roadway on foot, for the safety of everyone using the road.

Parks Canada is investing an unprecedented \$3 billion dollars over 5 years to support infrastructure work to heritage, tourism, waterway, and highway assets located within national historic sites, national parks, and national marine conservation areas across Canada. This investment will ensure these cherished places are protected and secured for the future.
