## **One Lane Opens at Horseshoe Lake Road** Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

**Peterborough, Ontario, March 28, 2017** – Horseshoe Lake Road (County Road 20) will open to one lane of traffic near the Horseshoe Lake Dam, below Bethel Road, on April 1, 2017. The road has been closed to facilitate work to replace Horseshoe Lake Dam, part of the Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site.

Pedestrian access through the construction site has thus far been maintained. Individuals are now asked to refrain from using the roadway on foot, for the safety of all. Both lanes of Horseshoe Lake Road are currently scheduled to open to vehicles in early May.

Significant infrastructure investments are being made in our national historic sites, national parks and national marine conservation areas.
