Sandbag operations will continue through Saturday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at the S.G. Nesbitt Community Centre location.

Residents are advised that sand and sandbags continue to be available at the following locations:

- S.G. Nesbitt Community Centre, located at 55 Parkside Street, Minden.
- Roads Department Yard #3, located at 4564 County Road 121 (Kinmount location), in the Sand Dome to the left of the entrance.
- Furnace Falls Park entrance, located on County Road 503.

Limited quantities of prepared sandbags will be available at the Minden location only. We kindly ask that you consider others and their ability to prepare their own sandbags when accessing this service.

This resource is primarily self-serve, please remember a shovel. Residents are encouraged to think of their neighbours - don't forget about those around you that may have difficulty with this task.
