RDS RFT 20-06 Reconstruction of Bobcaygeon Road

This addendum shall be incorporated into and form part of RFT No. 20-06 for the provision of **The Reconstruction of Bobcaygeon Road**.

Receipt of the Addendum shall be acknowledged as part of your submission as per Section 2.14 – Addenda of the RFT document and **must be included** in the submission package before the closing date of Tuesday September 1, 2020 at 12:00 noon.

The Township of Minden Hills reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders or accept any Proposal, should it deem such actions to be in the best interest of the Township.

This addendum consists of 2 pages & 1 drawing and clarifies additional details as follows:

- 1.) The locations of the straw bales and check dams are not shown on the drawings but will be required during construction. Placement will be in roadside ditching as directed/required to mitigate sediment runoff during construction.
- 2.) Blasting of rock is not anticipated; additional ditching is required, and rock excavation has been included as a provisional item.
- 3.) The ditching with subdrain will be located in the Scotch Line ditch shown on sheet 18. The Typical Drainage Swale w/ Subdrain detail on sheet 18 is accurate.
- 4.) Proof roll of the subgrade/pulverized material is acceptable. A density test is not required.
- 5.) HL1 has been specified due to the high truck traffic, a substitution for HL3 is not being considered.
- 6.) Asphalt warranty will be required. If due to weather and factors beyond the contractor's control, the base asphalt is not able to be completed within the temperature specifications the Township may consider having base asphalt completed in the spring of 2021.
- 7.) Topsoil depth on the site averages from 225mm to 300mm.
- 8.) Tender item 1.10 requires topsoil to be removed off-site, item 3.08 includes the import of new topsoil

- 9.) The Right-of-Way Pavement Structure on sheet 18 has been updated to reflect the HL1 required for the project.
- 10.) As per section; 3.6 Bonding, Bidders shall provide a Performance Bond in the amount of 100% and a Labour and Material Payment Bond and all bids shall include an agreement to bond.
