One Lane Open at Horseshoe Lake Road Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

Peterborough, Ontario, April 28, 2017 – Horseshoe Lake Road (County Road 20) near the Horseshoe Lake Dam, below Bethel Road, will remain open to one lane of traffic only until early June. The road was closed to facilitate work to replace Horseshoe Lake Dam, part of the Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site, and was opened to one lane of traffic on April 1, 2017.

Individuals have been asked to refrain from using the roadway on foot, for the safety of everyone using the road.

Significant infrastructure investments are being made in our national historic sites, national parks and national marine conservation areas.
