**DIRECTIONS TO WASTE DISPOSAL SITES & RECYCLING CENTRES**

Scotch Line

Highway 35 North to Scotch Line Road (just past the Subaru dealership on the left hand side). Turn left onto Scotch Line Road. Follow road approximately 1 km. Landfill is on the left. Or take Bobcaygeon Road North to Scotch Line Road, turn right onto Scotch Line. Landfill is on your right.

Ingoldsby

County Road 21 to Kashagawigamog Lake Road (County Road 18). Travel through Ingoldsby to the first road on the right past the bridge. Landfill is approximately ½ km on the left. Or take County Road 1 (Gelert Road) to Ingoldsby Road and follow for approximately 3km. Landfill is on the right.

Little Gull

Located on County Road 2 (Deep Bay Road), 4 km north of Highway 35, or 14 km south of Minden, just south of Little Gull Lake.

Iron Mine

Located on Davis Lake Road. Davis Lake Road is located north of Miner’s Bay Lodge off Highway No. 35. Go east on Davis Lake Road 4km. At the “y” in the road by the Radio Tower, take straight branch (left), 1km to landfill site.

Irondale

Located on Milburn Road 1km west of County Road 503, or 8km east of County Road 1(Gelert Road).

| E-Waste, television, monitors, etc.   | Free – Scotchline and Irondale Waste Disposal Sites & Recycling Centres           |
| Boat Shrink Wrap is permitted at Scotchline Landfill Site only within the month of July | \$26.00 per wrap – must be clean and tightly bundled with string                  |
| Yard Waste – grass clippings, leaves, weeds, pine needles                               | No Charge – Accepted at Scotchline only   |

**RECYCLING** (Recycling must be in blue boxes or transparent bags)

| <b>FIBERS</b> Please do not package "fibers" in plastic bags.   |   |

| <b>Newspapers, Magazines and Books</b>  | Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, glossy flyers, ad inserts, phone books and soft cover books  |
| <b>Boxboard &amp; Mixed Paper</b>   | Household & office paper, mail and envelopes, writing, computer & wrapping paper, greeting cards, cereal, detergent, tissue and shoe boxes, paper towel & toilet paper tubes, fiber egg cartons and plastic lined cat & dog food bags, paper shopping bags  |
| <b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>   | Pizza boxes & cardboard boxes. Clean & flatten. <b>No</b> waxed corrugated boxes or soiled pizza boxes.   |
| <b>CONTAINERS</b> Please rinse out bottles, jars and other containers.  |   |
| <b>Glass Bottles and Jars</b>   | All clear and coloured glass food and beverage containers   |
| <b>Tetra Pak Boxes, Plastic Containers &amp; Lids</b>   | Pop & water bottles, yogurt, margarine, ice cream, clear fruit/veggie containers, ketchup, dish soap, bleach, shampoo and vitamin bottles (marked 1-7 on the bottom), peanut butter jars, plastic milk bags, fabric softener, laundry detergent & windshield washer fluid jugs, juice, milk, soup & other "Tetra Pak" type boxes. <b>No</b> Straws. |
| <b>"Gable-Top" Cartons</b>  | Polycoat (waxed) milk, juice, sugar & liquid egg cartons coffee cups and fast food containers, paper plates (clean of food).  |
| <b>Metal Cans &amp; Foil</b>  | All tin & aluminum food & beverage cans. Clean aluminum foil, pie plates & take-out trays. Remove lids on tin cans, place inside can and pinch closed. Empty Aerosol Containers (Lids Removed)  |
| <b>Plastic Bags</b>   | Milk, bread, shopping & dry cleaning bags. Wrap from toilet paper, paper towels. No bubble or boat wrap, tarps or other large sheets of plastic film.   |
| <b>Polystyrene (Styrofoam)</b>  | Meat and bakery trays, egg cartons - <b>No</b> blue or pink styrofoam   |
| <b>Construction Material</b>  | Sort the metal, concrete, wood and shingles.  |
| <b>UN-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS</b>  |   |
| <b>NO</b> cosmetic containers, toothpaste tubes, stretch wrap, insulation, packing Styrofoam peanuts or beads. Vinyl siding, shower curtains, blister packs, hangers, foil laminates i.e. foil gift wrap, chip bags, tissues or paper towels. |   |

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE**

**Acceptable Hazardous Waste:** Rechargeable batteries (i.e. Phone & cellphone batteries), small household batteries, fluorescent bulbs, CFL bulbs, printer ink jets, toner cartridges, empty aerosol cans – in the RED bins at Scotch Line landfill site, all other sites, please give to the landfill attendant. DRY & EMPTY paint cans may be placed in the metal bins. Oil and Anti-Freeze containers as well as hydraulic pails and jugs **must be empty**.

**Accepted on Hazardous Waste Event Days Only at Scotch Line Landfill Site:** Latex and oil paints, finishing products; i.e., varnish, glues, etc., used motor oil, auto and marine batteries, propane tanks and cylinders, cleaners such as bleach, oven cleaner, etc., aerosol cans, solvents; i.e., varsol, paint thinners, pesticides and herbicides, pool and photographic.

**Unacceptable Waste Classes:** Needles/Sharps, PCB's radioactive and pathological waste.
