Subject: Winter Sand Use

Please be advised that as of February 7, 2019, the Township of Minden Hills has placed approximately 1,500 tonne of winter sand at the Community Centre Parking Lot for Residential Use. Due to the early onset of winter and multiple rain/thaw events the Township will be rationing any future sand placed at the Community Centre Parking Lot.

The Township would like to remind the public that:

- The sand stockpile is for **personal use only** and **no more** than **one (1) five (5) gallon container may be taken per vehicle.**
- This sand shall not be used by contractors, commercial businesses, non-Minden Hills Residents, private roads or other government agencies.
- Entry into Public Works Yards (sand domes) are strictly prohibited.

Many local Contractors are available for hire to provide sanding to residents/commercial business and private roads. Alternatively, sand may be purchased by residents at local businesses.
