Subject: Fire Season Information

The Township would like to remind the public that “Fire Season” is from April 1st to October 31st each year. During this period, daytime burning is not allowed without a Burn Permit.

If you wish to burn during the day, you must apply for a Burn Permit, which can be obtained online at www.mindenhills.ca/emergency-fire-services/fire-prevention/ or in person at the Township Administration office, 2nd floor.

The cost of a Burn Permit is \$50.00 and a minimum of two (2) business days is required to process the permits.

A reminder that anyone setting an outdoor fire is responsible for any damage to property or injury to persons, and is liable for all costs incurred by the Fire Department. Contravention of these restrictions will result in fines as set out in the Township’s Comprehensive Fees and Charges Bylaw #18-86.

Fire Bans

A total ban against outdoor burning may be declared when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances warrant it. It is YOUR responsibility to be aware of fire bans. You can also view the fire meter on the home page of the Township’s website at www.mindenhills.ca.
