Subject: Road Closures Update for April 22, 2019 – McKnight Drive and Anson Street Closed

Please be advised of the following road closures as a result of spring melt/flooding and wet road conditions:

McKnight Drive has been closed to all traffic. A barricade has been placed at Bobcaygeon Road.

Anson Street has been closed but remains open to local traffic only. A barricade has been placed at the west end of Peck Street.

Hospitality Road has been closed but remains open to local traffic. Barricades have been placed 1.8km east of Rice Road and at Hartle Lane.

Spring Valley Road has been closed to all traffic. Barricades have been placed at #1268 Spring Valley Road.

Ritchie Falls Road has been closed but remains open to local traffic only. Barricades have been placed at the Rail Trail.

Mark Twain Road has been closed to all traffic. Barricades have been placed at County Road 503.

Salerno Lake Road Bridge has been closed to all traffic. Barricades have been placed at Hancock Road and at the Public Boat Launch.

Snowmobile Bridge downtown Minden on the Gull River has been closed to all traffic, including pedestrians, due to high water levels.

Milburn Road remains closed from 2.0km east of Country Road 1 to 0.5km west of the Irondale Waste Disposal Site (1.7km west of County Road 503). Local traffic may continue to access their dwellings.

The closures will remain in effect until road conditions are deemed appropriate for reopening.

A reminder that private roads are not monitored by the Township. Residents needing to access these roads should do so with caution.
