SUBJECT: Public Notice – Registration of Property Flooding and Evacuees

Further to the Minden Hills Declaration of Emergency Status on April 24, 2019, we encourage residents to take additional precautions to protect personal safety and property. **In the event of an emergency please call 911.**

With rising water levels, residents, small businesses, farms and not-for-profit organizations of Minden Hills are asked to register their flooded property and/or, if self-evacuating, with the Recovery/Event Coordinator at 705-286-1260 ext. 211 or after hours at 1-866-856-3247. To register your property, please be prepared with the following information:

- Name
- 911 Number (Street Address)
- Which structures are affected (i.e. main residence, garage, store, other buildings)
- Contact Phone Number

The public is advised to use extreme caution around area lakes, rivers, creeks and other water sources such as ditches, as high water levels and swift currents can create dangerous conditions.

Avoid driving on any roadways that are underwater, as road conditions may be unstable and dangerous.
