**Subject: Minden Hills COVID-19 Update,
Account Holder Construction and Demolition Disposal**

Minden Hills, April 28, 2020 – Effective May 4, 2020 the Township of Minden Hills will begin accepting construction and demolition materials at the Scotch Line Landfill from **existing account holders only**

Please read the following information to ensure you are fully aware of these changes and how materials will be receipted and tipped.

-) Effective May 4, 2020 existing account holders will be able to tip Construction and Demolition Waste at the Scotch Line Landfill;
-) At this time, the Township **will not be** accepting applications for new accounts;
-) Existing Account Holders shall park and/or wait in the designated area shown below;



-) Account Holders shall; turn off their ignition, and remain in their vehicle at all times. Landfill staff will need to record information during this time and will require you to answer the following questions:

- 1) Account Holder Information (name, and phone number)
- 2) Origin of the construction waste (name, address and phone number)
- 3) Verbal Confirmation that there is no asbestos or hazardous wastes in the load

At that time Landfill Staff will also record the license plate of the vehicle, volume of load and whether it is sorted or not. Landfill Staff will verbally inform the driver of the recorded volume.

-) Landfill Staff will not be issuing a receipt to ensure adequate social distance is maintained.
-) All receipts are considered final and will not be adjusted at a later date.

- **Verbal or Physical Harassment/Abuse will not be tolerated from any visitor to the site and will result in the banning from entry to all Township owned Waste Sites in Minden Hills.**
- **Any loads found to have any asbestos or hazardous waste material will result in the removal of the account and be reported to the Ministry of Environment, Climate and Parks.**
- **Account Holders may not allow non-account holders to charge to their account.**
- **Applications for New Accounts are not being accepted at this time.**
- **Construction and Demolition Materials brought in by non-account holders will be refused. Any illegal tipping will be recorded and reported to the OPP and Ministry of Environment, Climate and Parks**

At this time the Township is not accepting other streams of waste and will update this as the COVID-19 situation improves along with the Province reducing restrictions in the future.

The Municipality will continue to communicate all information by means of media broadcasting and media releases to radio stations, local newspapers and our website.
