**Subject: Minden Hills COVID-19 Update, Construction Industry  
(Septic Permits)**

Following the May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Provincial statement regarding the construction industry and efforts to begin re-opening certain business sectors, the municipalities of Haliburton County will resume issuing permits for On-Site Sewage Systems, effective Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>.

At this time, permits for building and/or demolition will continue to be accepted for review but will not be issued until the provincial government removes restrictions for such construction projects.

These municipal changes should be followed in conjunction with the provincial restrictions of limited gatherings, social distancing, etc.

The Municipality will continue to communicate all information by means of media broadcasting and media releases to radio stations, local newspapers and our website.
