Subject: Hazardous Waste Day August 8, 2020

Residents of Minden Hills are invited to bring household hazardous waste to the Scotch Line Landfill on Saturday, Aug 8 from 8am to 11:30am.

IMPORTANT:

- attendees will not be permitted to exit their vehicles at the hazardous waste drop off location
- event staff will unload your materials for you; please ensure items are accessible
- site staff will be providing you instruction at various checkpoints on site – please stop to receive direction when asked
- help us serve everyone quickly and efficiently by remaining in your vehicle, staying in line and following site staff instructions

Please be patient with wait times – site staff will be unloading vehicles as quickly as possible. Exiting your vehicle to help unload or to “cut the line” will slow down our operation and put others at risk and you may be asked to leave the site.

If you are not comfortable with your vehicle being unloaded on your behalf, please choose to attend a future event.

To save time and a trip, please note that the following are not hazardous waste:

- incandescent and LED lightbulbs (garbage)
- empty paint cans (recycling)
- empty aerosol cans (recycling)
- empty containers from cleaners, etc. (recycling)
- dried paintbrushes and rags (garbage)
