Subject: COVID-19 UPDATE - Minden Hills Community Centre/Recreation Complex/S.G. Nesbitt Memorial Arena

As of **January 5, 2022 at 12:01 AM**, the province of Ontario is temporarily moving into Step Two of the Roadmap to Reopen. Please refer to [O. Reg. 263/20 Rules for Areas in Step 2](#) for the complete list of measures and conditions.

Under the current provincial order, the Minden Hills Community Centre/Recreation Complex/S.G. Nesbitt Memorial Arena will be closed to the public and all programs and services are suspended at this time. However, once allowable, the Municipality will assess re-opening the facility and program availability based on the province of Ontario's COVID-19 response framework and recommendations from the Haliburton Kawartha Pine Ridge District Health Unit (HKPR).

IMPORTANT: The Mass Immunization Clinics at the Minden Community Centre will continue as scheduled.
