**SUBJECT: UPDATE – Soyers Lake Road Reopened**

Please be advised that Soyers Lake Road, previously closed due to flooding has been reopened.

A reminder that private roads are not being monitored by the Township and those residents needing to access these roads should do so with caution.

Avoid driving on any roadways that are underwater, as road conditions may be unstable and dangerous.

The public is reminded to use caution around area lakes, rivers, creeks and other water sources such as ditches, as high water levels and swift currents can create unstable conditions.
