To Regulate the Installation of Signs on Municipal  
Roads

### **Definitions and Interpretation Rules**

Wherever a word is used in this Policy with its first letter capitalized, the term is being used as it is defined in this Section. Where any word appears in ordinary case, its regularly applied meaning in the English language is intended. Defined terms may be used throughout this policy in different grammatical contexts.

“**Municipality**” means the Township of Minden Hills.

“**Non-Regulatory Signs**” means signage that is not intended to regulate and control traffic.

“**Regulatory Signs**” means signs that are intended to instruct or give direction to users on the road on what they must do under a set of circumstances, to regulate and control traffic.

“**Road Superintendent**” means the Road Superintendent of the Township of Minden Hills.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this Policy is to regulate the installation of regulatory and non-regulatory signs on Municipal Roads.

### **General**

The Township receives requests for the installation of regulatory and non-regulatory signs on Municipal roads. The objective of this policy is to regulate the installation of regulatory signs and non-regulatory signs on Municipal Roads.

### **Scope**

This policy shall apply to all municipal roads throughout the Township of Minden Hills.


## **Guiding Principles**

1. The costs and installation of all regulatory signs on Municipal roads shall be the responsibility of the Municipality. Regulatory signs shall include but not be limited to stop signs, speed signs and yield signs.
2. Requests for the installation of all non-regulatory signs on Municipal roads shall be made in writing to the Road Superintendent. Non-regulatory signs shall include but not be limited to hidden entrance signs, dead end signs, private road signs and children playing signs.
3. The placement of non-regulatory signs on Municipal roads shall be the responsibility of the Municipality.
4. The responsibility for the costs of the non-regulatory signs and posts shall be determined by the Road Superintendent on an individual basis.
