Rules and Regulations



Application Information

1. The purpose of the application is to:
 - ensure a variety of hand crafted products are being sold
 - ensure fairness to all vendors
 - ensure vendors are aware of the rules of the market

PLEASE NOTE: Your application may not be approved if we are finding there are a number of vendors who are already selling a similar product.

2. A completed application form must be accompanied with payment **by Monday November 18th**. Application forms and payment will **NOT** be accepted the day of the market.
3. Applications and payments can be sent in by mail or submitted in person. Payment options include: cash, cheque, debit or credit card. Cheques can be made out to the Township of Minden Hills

In person: **Scout Hall (Behind the arena) or Nature's Place (beside the library)**
4. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.**
5. Only products that are handcrafted by the vendor can be sold at the market.

Space Allocation

1. The cost for one space is \$10 (HST included) and the space is roughly 6' x8'. The spaces may be larger (8'x8') depending on the number of vendors that participate.
2. **The maximum number of booths per vendor allowed is 2, to allow for more variety in the show**
3. Each space will consist of 1 table (either 5' or 6' in length) and 2 chairs provided by the Township. Vendors are welcome to bring other items for display purposes which they will be responsible for setting up and tearing down.
4. Sharing of space with another vendor is permitted
5. The show will be taking place at the SG Nesbitt Community Centre (55 Parkside Street)

Vendor Conduct

1. Vendors should allow themselves sufficient time to set up their space and be prepared to serve customers as soon as the show opens at 11am. **Doors will be open by 8:00 am for vendors to set up.**
2. Vendors are expected to keep their spaces open for the entire duration of the show and not to begin tear down until it has closed at 4pm. **If you do not follow this requirement you may not be allowed to return the following year.**
3. When you are done unloading your vehicle **please move it to the parking lot of the curling club or arena to allow for accessible visitors parking. Please do not leave your vehicle by the Community Centre.**
